### **RYA Online CEVNI test - Advice for candidates**

The CEVNI test is required for holders of the International Certificate of Competence (ICC), for it to be endorsed for inland waters outside the UK. It is now available on line, saving you the travel and time involved in a written test. The new on line test is on the RYA e-learning website,

The test fee is £25.00, payable to Skysail Training. (Including the RYA fee of £12.00).

A practice test is available to help you check you are ready for the real test. It's up to you to try this, and your scores are not recorded. It will confirm you are ready to take the test, or suggest you to talk to me about tuition, or to take a longer look at the European Waterways Regulations book by Tam Murrell, available here:

The test is split into two parts:

Part 1: Signs and buoyage.

Part 2: Sound signals, lights and shapes.

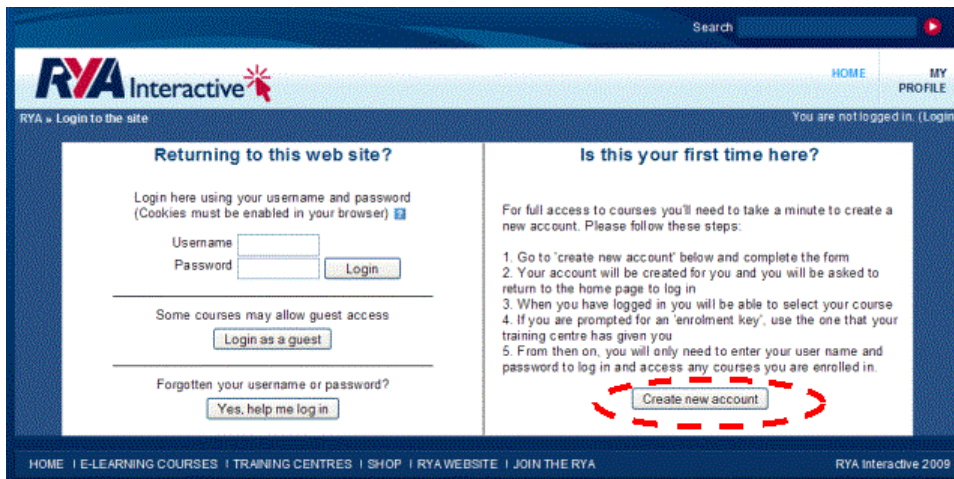
There are 15 questions in each part, and you must answer at least 11 questions correctly in each part to pass the complete test. After you have passed, you can download a certificate that can be used to apply for your ICC Inland endorsement.

**Register for the test** - There are two steps to get into the test:

**Create an account:** Go to <http://www.ryainteractive.org./index.php?centre=skysail-training&course=Guest>

1. **'Login'** in the top right corner of the home page, then click **'Create new account'**.

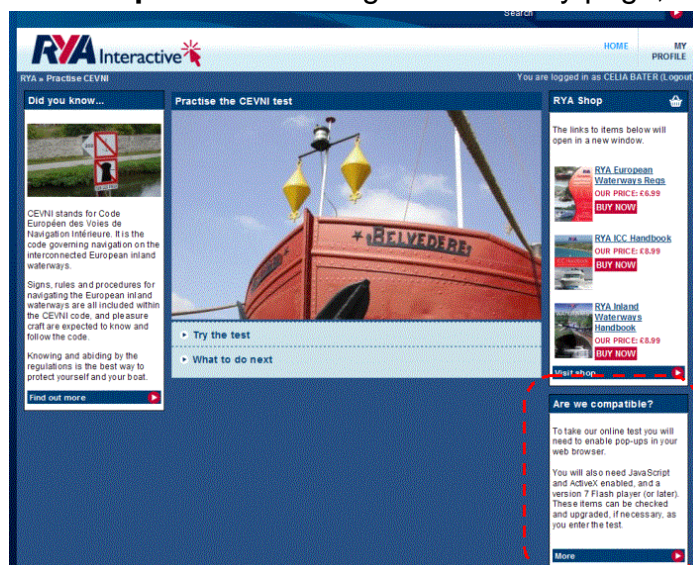




You will be asked for personal details and then select 'Skysail Training' if offered a list of centres. Note the ICC is only available to applicants over the age of 16. Then choose your own user name and password and you will have access to the site generally, using that name and password.



Click on 'The CEVNI test' which will give you the option of practice or real tests. Make sure you click 'Are we compatible' to the right of the entry page, and allow popups.

Note: the Practice test is open to anyone who is registered on the site, and does not require an enrolment PIN number.

**2. Enrolling for the test:** When you have paid the £25.00 fee to Skysail Training I will send you an enrolment PIN, which is personal to you. You can pay by cheque or I can send a Paypal Invoice payable via Paypal or Credit Card. By entering the PIN you will be able to take the real test. You will have two attempts to pass each part of the test. If you are not successful you can be given repeat access at a later date for another two attempts (when you have done more homework!). Please contact me if you need to arrange for repeat access to the test.

If you prefer you can take the written test here at Skysail Training, fee £20.00.
